## FREQUENTIS C4i and Lockheed Martin Australia partner to deliver secure communications for AIR6500

- Australia Defence Force to utilise C4i's VOICE C2 multi-domain communications
- Under the contract, C4i is creating advanced, sovereign voice communication systems that integrate with command networks to support secure multi-domain defence operations

Frequentis C4i announces that it has been under contract since 2024 to provide cutting-edge multidomain communication systems for the Australia Defence Force's (ADF) next-generation AIR6500 Joint Air Battle Management System. C4i's partnership with Lockheed Martin Australia represents a significant milestone in the company's ongoing collaboration, building on the success of initial capability demonstrations.

Under the contract, C4i is developing sovereign voice communication systems with a built-in intuitive Human Machine Interface that will connect into Joint Air Battlement Management C2 networks.

The AIR6500 program is a key element of the ADF's national security strategy, enhancing capabilities across air, land, sea, cyber, and space. Frequentis C4i's innovative technology will serve as the backbone of these efforts, enabling secure, real-time communications critical for joint force operations.

"By integrating our advanced hardware and software solutions, we are enhancing the ability of the military to communicate securely and effectively across all domains. This capability is vital for responding to threats quickly, especially in challenging environments," said Darren Gardner, Managing Director, Frequentis C4i. "Lockheed Martin is actively showcasing Australia's next-gen air battle management technology on the world stage, positioning C4i technology as a key element in international defence initiatives. In addition to bolstering Australia's defence capabilities, this collaboration will open up new export opportunities for C4i to participate in global defence projects. Lockheed Martin Australia is drawing on the best of Australian industry to deliver AIR6500, which has the potential to provide a pipeline into the global integrated air and missile defence market estimated to be worth AUD 83 billion.
